Week 2:

LEADERSHIP: VISION

MEMORY VERSE:

Proverbs 29:18, "Where there is no vision, the people perish." (KJV)

BOTTOM LINE:

If you want to be a leader, you must know where you are going.

2. BIBLE TIME

READ:

- Proverbs 29:18
- Habakkuk 2:2
- 1 Corinthians 2:9-10

MAIN POINT:

It is clear in the Bible that God has a plan for our lives. He not only knows the plan, but He wants us to know the plan too. He wants us to SEE ourselves fulfilling the plan He has for our lives. No matter how old we are, we can picture (in our heart) ourselves doing what God has called us to do.

DISCUSS:

- What can you see yourself doing?
- Do you have to wait until you graduate from college to do what God wants you to do?
- How can you take what you see yourself doing and influence others now?

QUESTIONS TO ASK:

1. What do you see yourself doing for God?
2. Why do you think it's important to picture yourself doing things for God, before you do them?
3. Why do you think it's important to God that good leaders SEE first?

3. FAMILY TIME

GOD'S Pictionary

MAIN POINT:

Allow God to show you what He wants you to do.

WHAT YOU NEED:

Pictionary game, paper and pencils

WHAT YOU DO:

- Gather the family together for a family game of Pictionary. If you don't have the board game; that's ok (all you need is pencils, paper and a timer).
- Divide the family into 2 teams.
- Team #1 must give Team #2 something to draw (make sure it's not too hard for the younger players).

- Using the timer, give each team 1 minute to draw their item (take turns being the drawer).
- Each time a team guesses what was drawn they get a point. First team to 10 points wins!

DISCUSS:

- Playing Pictionary is a lot like how God wants us to play life.
- He draws a picture on our hearts of what He's called us to do for Him.
- The only way we can do what He's called us to do is to first SEE the picture of ourselves doing it.
- Every good leader sees themselves doing what their goals are, before they actually do it.
- Let God play Pictionary on your heart, He'll draw you a picture that is better than any picture you would ever draw for yourself!
