## 2. BIBLETIME

#### **READ:**

- Hebrews 12:1
- Philippians 3:14

#### **MAIN POINT:**

There are three important things to remember when running your race: Life is a marathon, not a sprint. You will make mistakes. Forget the past, get back up and keep running.

#### **DISCUSS:**

The Bible describes our life on earth as a race. There are different kinds of races: some are sprints and some run marathons. A sprint is a race runners run very fast for a short distance. A marathon goes at a slower pace and the race is very long.

Gods race for us is like a marathon; it isn't accomplished quickly. The things God has called leaders to do will be things they will do for a life time; our races aren't finished until we get to heaven.
